The conference will take place from 22-24 March 2026 at St Catherine's College in Oxford, UK, and will feature a keynote, panels, and sessions from a range of development economics topics. The CSAE is turning 40 years old in 2026, join us to celebrate at this year's event.



### HOW TO SUBMIT

To submit a paper for consideration you must complete the submission form by 14 September 2025.  
FUNDING: Applications for funding must be submitted by 03 August 2025.

### SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Only FULL DRAFTS of papers will be considered.
- You are required to submit an abstract for your paper.
- Authors can ONLY SUBMIT ONE PAPER.
- Papers must be submitted and presented in English.
